### Sen. Sinema Threatened To Derail The Build Back Better Budget After Taking Over \$920,000 From The Industry Groups And Their Corporate Allies Leading The Fight Against Its Provisions

**SUMMARY:** In late August 2021, Sen. Kyrsten Sinema (D-AZ) threatened to "<u>derail</u>" the \$3.5 trillion budget that is key to advancing President Biden's Build Back Better agenda—which would "<u>create jobs, cut taxes,</u> <u>and lower costs for working families.</u>" At the same time, a "<u>torrent of political groups</u>" representing the nation's biggest industries prepared a "lobbying blitz" against the budget's proposals, including those to make corporations pay their fair share.

Sen. Sinema has taken at least \$923,065 from the industry groups leading this charge against the Build Back Better budget or from the individual corporations these groups represent:

- The RATE Coalition—Whose Major Corporate Members Gave \$210,000 To Sen. Sinema—Was Poised For A "<u>Seven-Figure</u>" Ad Buy Against The Build Back Better Budget.
- The National Association Of Manufacturers (NAM)—Which Gave \$10,000 To Sinema As Its Leading Corporate Members Gave Her \$32,500—Was Poised To Ally With The U.S. Chamber's Fight Against The Budget And Was Lobbying On It "<u>In Every Way You Can Imagine</u>."
- **PhRMA**—Which Gave \$6,000 To Sinema, Along With Its Major Members' \$23,000—Has <u>Run Ads</u> Against The \$3.5 Trillion Package And Has Spent More Than <u>\$15 Million</u> On Lobbying This Year.

### PhRMA Has A History Of Siding With Right-Leaning Groups To Oppose Democratic Priorities, Like The Reconciliation Bill And Drug Pricing Reforms.

PhRMA Has Backed Groups That Have "Sharply" Criticized Democrats, Including The "Right-Leaning American Action Network," Which Announced A \$5 Million Ad Campaign Against The Reconciliation Package In August 2021. "Many of these groups, which have taken PhRMA money in the past, have run ads sharply criticizing Democrats, including the party's most vulnerable lawmakers entering the 2022 midterms. One such group, the right-leaning American Action Network, in August announced a \$5 million ad campaign against Democrats that blasted the reconciliation package broadly and likened its drug pricing proposals to socialism. The network has received past support from PhRMA, including a \$4.5 million donation reported on the pharmaceutical group's 2019 tax filings, which were obtained by The Washington Post from the Center for Responsive Politics. Ron Wyden (D-Ore.), leader of the Finance Committee that oversees prescription drug pricing. 'Imagine a future in which a coronavirus vaccine was never discovered,' began the 30-second television spot, before flashing images of emptied classrooms, shuttered storefronts and Americans sleeping on the streets. Faulting Wyden's proposals, the ad concluded, 'It won't be hard to imagine at all.'" [The Washington Post, 08/31/21]
