

# 78 Top Corporations And Trade Associations Gave Over \$630,000 To The Sedition Caucus In September 2021

**SUMMARY:** Throughout 2021, top corporations and trade groups have [donated](#) over \$5.8 million to [Republicans](#) who voted against certifying the 2020 Presidential election. In just September, these companies and organizations contributed **\$636,814** to the Sedition Caucus, including:

- **The American Bankers Association**, who despite calling the insurrection an ["assault on our democracy,"](#) donated a sum total of \$42,000 to GOP House caucus members such as Rep. Devin Nunes (CA-22) and Rep. Virginia Foxx (NC-05).
- **Marathon Petroleum** called the insurrection ["appalling"](#) donated a total of **\$32,500** to Republicans such as Rep. Richard Hudson (NC-08) and Rep. Stephanie Bice (OK-05) who would not vote to certify the election.
- **The National Electrical Contractors Association (NECA)** [warned](#) staff about being in DC because of the dangers of the insurrectionists, but still donated **\$30,000** to members such as Rep. Brian Mast (FL-18) and Rep. Lisa McClain (MI-10).
- **The National Cattlemen's Beef Association** donated **\$28,500** To Republicans such as Rep. Tracey Mann (KS-01) and Rep. Adrian Smith (NE-03).
- **Boeing** [halted](#) contributions to PACs following the insurrection, but donated a sum total of **\$28,500** Republicans who objected to the election, such as Rep. Trent Kelly (MS-01) and Rep. Michael Guest (MS-03).
- **Pfizer** claimed it would not donate to any of the 147 congressmembers who would not certify the 2020 Election results, but still donated a total of **\$13,500** to members such as Rep. Devin Nunes (CA-22) and Rep. Kevin Hern (OK-01).

The American Bankers Association Paused Contributions Following What It Called "The Troubling Events" Of January 6 And Referred To The Insurrection "An Assault On Our Democracy." "The political action committee of the American Bankers Association (ABA), a trade association for the industry, is the second biggest donor to the 147 Republican senators and representatives who objected to states' election results last week. It has donated \$1.32 million to these lawmakers, according to data from Open Secret. The group will consider the 'troubling events of the last week' when making donations, and has currently paused all political contributions, it told a spokesperson told Insider, but hasn't announced plans to halt any funding." The Ohio-based firm did not say when it would resume them. I have encouraged all staff in the Washington, D.C., region to stay home and stay safe, and to remain there until it is safe to leave. 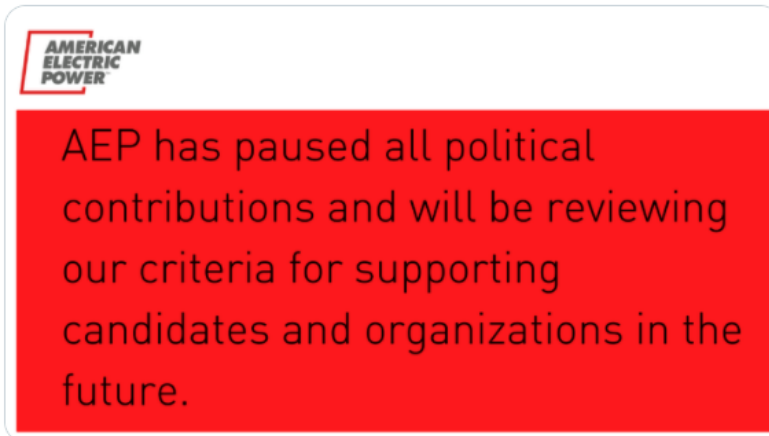
