

During The 2022 Election Cycle, Major Corporations That Commemorated Women's History Month Or International Women's Day Gave Over \$850,000 To Lawmakers Who Blocked Federal Voting Protections That Would Help The Women These Companies Claim To Celebrate

SUMMARY: During the 2022 election cycle, major corporations that have publicly touted their celebrations of women—for International Women's Day and Women's History Month—and claim to support voting rights contributed over **\$850,000** to Senate Republicans who blocked two pieces of federal voting rights legislation, the [Freedom to Vote Act](#) (FTVA) and the [John Lewis Voting Rights Advancement Act](#) (JLVRAA). The legislation would have helped ensure, according to The League Of Women Voters all Americans could cast their ballots "regardless of their age, race, sex, language, or zip code." Voter suppression efforts are used to target women of color voters, making federal voting rights protections essential for women of color.

Several companies that claim to support for voting rights have donated at least **\$854,000** in the 2022 election cycle to the Senate Republicans who vehemently oppose the expansion of access to the ballot:

- **Verizon** commemorated both Women's History Month and International Women's Day but has donated **\$138,000** to Senate Republicans in the 2022 election cycle.
- **Amazon** commemorated International Women's Day but has donated **\$107,500** to Senate Republicans in the 2022 election cycle.
- **Citigroup** commemorated International Women's Day but has donated **\$33,500** to Senate Republicans in the 2022 election cycle.
- **Walgreens Boot Alliance** commemorated Women's History Month but has donated **\$23,000** to Republicans who will not support the Freedom to Vote Act in the 2022 election cycle.
- **Walmart** commemorated Women's History Month but has donated **\$175,500** to Senate Republicans in the 2022 election cycle.
- **Microsoft Corporation** commemorated both Women's History Month and International Women's Day but has donated **\$135,000** to Senate Republicans in the 2022 election cycle.
- **Intel Corporation** commemorated International Women's Day but has donated **\$57,000** to Senate Republicans in the 2022 election cycle.
- **Cisco** commemorated International Women's Day but has donated **\$12,500** to Senate Republicans in the 2022 election cycle.
- **Boston Scientific** commemorated International Women's Day but has donated **\$27,500** to Senate Republicans in the 2022 election cycle.
- **Google** commemorated International Women's Day but has donated **\$144,500** to Senate Republicans in the 2022 election cycle.

Corporate hypocrisy is on display yet again as these companies publicly commemorate Women's History Month and International Women's Day and make platitudes supporting voting rights while they bolster the coffers of the politicians currently blocking voting reform legislation from passing.

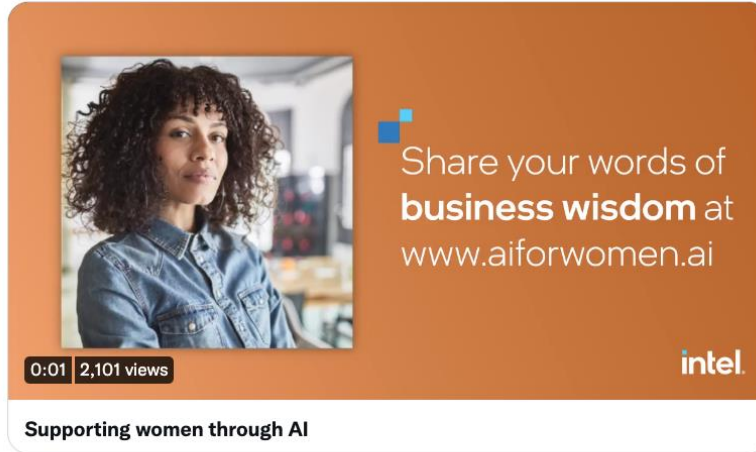
